Payment, Cancellation, Changes & Refund Policy
Studies and Tuition

- All students must have paid for their program IN FULL by the FIRST day of classes or they will not be permitted to attend classes.
- No Tuition refunds will be made after classes begin regardless of reason for departure. Cancellations must be submitted in writing.
- The \$120 Registration Fee is not refundable but may be applied toward future registrations in the same calendar year.
- Tuition and Study Materials Fees are refundable for those who cancel 2 weeks or more before their intended start date. Rennert will make all refunds within 30 days only to the person or agency that paid the school. Students who have paid their tuition through agents must apply to that agency for a refund.
